## Goal Three: Students will use world languages to increase their understanding of the home language and culture. 3.1 Analyze use of linguistic elements. 3.2 Analyze grammatical structures.

- Use linguistic elements of home/target languages to convey meaning in communication.
- Apply knowledge of the target language vocabulary to improve command of the home language.
- Continue to learn and apply proper grammatical structures and syntax of the target language to increase the comprehension and effective use of the home language.
- Compare/Contrast grammatical structures between target language/home language.
- Analyze the impact of German culture on the home culture.
- Evaluate the impact of various social contributions of the target culture on the home culture.

Goal Four: Use world languages to interact in multilingual communities and to analyze career options in a global marketplace.

- 4.1 Use culturally authentic texts and media as a response for personal, academic, and professional growth.
- 4.2 Analyze the use of the target language in the community, state, nation, and world.
- 4.3 Evaluate career options and needs of corporation and businesses of the target language and culture.

- Discuss the benefits of multiple language knowledge in world economics.
- Analyze how understanding more than one language & culture supports professional development and career growth, and earning potential.
- Consider how understanding more than one language & culture can open doors to the world on a personal level.
- Analyze various authentic, expressive art forms to determine past and present perspectives of the target culture.

Goal Five: Students will use knowledge and perspectives that can be gained only through the target language and culture.

- 5.1 Integrate information and perspectives gained from the target language and culture into various aspects of learning.
- 5.2 Analyze the impact of current and historical events on the lives of people in the target culture.
- 5.3 Evaluate how different cultural perspectives influence people's reactions to world issues and events.

- Examine the interconnections of language.
- Apply understanding of German to enhance/facilitate other language study.
- Analyze the influence of key individuals on the development of the target culture (e.g., religious, military, governmental).
- Describe major changes/events that have influenced the target culture.
- Discuss world events as they occur.
- Examine cultural sensitivities (e.g., censorship, race, religion)
- Apply language skills in ethnic events, personal conversation, and travel.
